GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS TO BIDDERS

1. The following material is available for disposal on "As is where is" basis:-

2. The rate quoted should be valid for a minimum period of 60 days from the date of forward auction held. No bidder is permitted to withdraw their offer within the validity period of the tender or before finalization of the order. In such case EMD will be forfeited & Bidder will be blacklisted. The Order will be valid for a period of sugar season from the date of Sale Order / Letter of Indent with a provision for extension of One Month from the date of expiry of validity of order . In case required, TNPL may propose additional quantity during the validity period of sale order and the buyer shall clear the materials as per the rate, terms and condition of Tender / Sale Order.

3. Tender should be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit in the form of Demand draft in favour of Tamilnadu Newsprint and papers Ltd payable at Karur. The Earnest Money deposit of the successful bidder shall be converted into Security Deposit and shall be returned after satisfactory completion of the sale order.

4. **SECURITY DEPOSIT:** The EMD amount remitted by the successful bidder will be converted into security deposit. The Security deposit will be refunded after completion of sale order. This amount shall stand forfeited in the event of failure to execute the sale order satisfactorily and alternate arrangement will be made and difference in cost if any will be collected from you.

5. The buyer shall be allowed to lift the material only after pre-payment for the quantity available including the applicable taxes. The remittance has to be made by Demand Draft in favour of Tamil Nadu Newsprint And Papers Limited, payable at Karur. The buyer shall keep a recurring Advance amount equivalent to one month expected quantity of material rounded off to the nearest thousand.

6. TNPL reserves the right to reject any/all tenders without assigning any reason at their discretion. The sale order may be issued to one/more parties at the discretion of TNPL.

7. The buyer should produce the TIN & PAN Number and a copy of the documentary proof along with Tender.

8. The storage area should be away from residential area and road side.

9. The details of anticipated generation of Ash from offsite are given below:

10. Any dispute arising out of the sale shall be subject to jurisdiction of town in which the TNPL office of issue of sale order exists.

11. Buyer should strictly follow the safety and security rules & regulations of the company. Buyer shall ensure that the surrounding area at the point of collection shall be kept clean & tidy and any spill out shall be collected by the them as per the instructions of TNPL officials Any spill out inside the premises while transporting for weighment and onward shall also be collected by the buyer.

12. You shall mobilize the necessary manpower including unskilled labour and supervisors for the effective execution of the work with necessary insurance cover for all crew including drivers and cleaners of your vehicles engaged for this work. You shall provide all amenities as per the statutory requirement to them at your cost.

13. Collected ash should not be dumped in the private / public lands causing inconvenience to people & establishments / authorities. Any expenditure that may be incurred by TNPL on account of the above will be deducted to the contractors account.

14. The following conditions may be taken note:

- a) Ash cannot be accumulated in the Sugar mill premises
- b) Ash waste is to be cleared on day to day basis

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15. Details of land in possession / lease with adequate pollution control facilities and TNPCB authorisation / No Objection certificate to store / handle ash waste is to be provided by the buyer.

16. ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS FOR DISPOSAL OF FLY ASH /CONDITIONED ASH/WET ASH FROM ESP ASH SILO FROM MOHANUR OFF SITE:

- 1.) A copy of Valid Consent Order to operate standing in the name of the tenderer issued by TNPCB under both Water and Air act to store FLY ASH /CONDITIONED ASH/WET ASH should be submitted along with tender document.
- 2) Period of sale order will be limited up to the validity of the consent order
- 3) If the storage land is owned by the tenderer, sufficient valid documentary proof should be submitted along with tender document.
- 4) If the storage land is a lease land, lease deed in Rs.100/= stamp paper, signed by 2 witnesses should be submitted along with tender document.

17. PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED BY WASTE MATERIALS HANDLING CONTRACTORS:

- 1) Contractor shall ensure that the body, platform and doors of the trucks are in good condition. The trucks will be inspected periodically by the officer in charge for the above and defects, if any, noticed, shall be rectified immediately by the concerned contractors. During the time of repair, alternative trucks have to be mobilized by the contractor.
- 2) Contractor shall collect / load the material to three inches lower than the side body / door height.
- 3) Materials shall be evenly leveled within the body of the vehicle immediately after collection / loading.
- 4) Before moving the trucks out of the loading / collection point, material sticking to tyres must be cleaned by scraping / water washing.
- 5) All trucks carrying waste materials shall move through the specified route to the dump yard.
- 6) Contractors shall ensure that waste materials does not spill from the trucks during transportation from the collection point to dump yards.

18. VALIDITY: The Sale Order shall be kept valid for a period of current sugar season and also special season from the date of release of Sale Order with a provision for further extension of One month from the date of expiry of validity of order.

19. Before winding up the operation at Sugar Mill site at the end of the contract period, the buyer shall obtain a work completion certificate from the Section-in-charge. In case of non – compliance to the conditions of the sale order, TNPL reserves the right to cancel the sale order and award the same on alternate source at the cost of the buyer and the Security Deposit will be forfeited.

ANNEXURE - I
GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR FORWARD AUCTION

I). SELECTION PROCESS OF BUYERS:

- a) Buyers must submit the process compliance statement duly signed, to TNPL before 48 hours of the commencement of auction.
- b) Subsequently, TNPL would communicate the opening price, bid increment and alias name through Internet.
- c) On the event date, Buyers shall submit bids from their computers through Internet on www.tnpltenders.com. As and when other Buyers place the bids, they would have the opportunity to revise their bids upwards, if they wish to do so.
- d) Buyers must communicate their final bid amount by fax or E-mail to TNPL immediately after the bid event. This may be followed by a hard copy communication of price by post or courier.
- e) At the end of the event, TNPL will have a list of all the Buyers with their final bids and will decide on releasing sale order based on the highest bid.
- f) TNPL's decision on sale order shall be final and binding. In case two Buyers emerge as H1 in the bidding, the Buyer who has placed the bid early would be considered active H1 and given weightage.

II). Opening price:

1. Opening price is defined as the highest initial price.
2. Buyers can bid higher than the opening price.

III). Bid increment:

Bid increment is the minimum fixed amount by which the next bid value can be increased. TNPL reserves the right to change the bid increment during the course of bidding.

IV). Bid event format:

This bid event will be conducted in standard English price bid event, with Alias name format. You will be able to see your price as well as alias name, however, your identity as well as others identities would be kept confidential.

V). Bidding Process:

Lot No, quantity, Date & Time will be communicated by TNPL.

VI). EVENT INFORMATION:

a). Extension Rule:

- ✍ There would be system generated Auto Extensions of 5 minutes each, if there is a bid placed by any participating Buyer(s) in the last 5 minutes.
- ✍ Extension of 5 minutes would happen for any number of times, if a bid (s) is placed in the last 5 minutes.
- ✍ Extension will cease to occur, if no bids (s) are placed in the last 5 minutes.

b). Illustration:

- V) If a bid is placed between 14:55 Hours to 15.00 hours(say 14.57) the bidding would be extended till 15.05 hours.
- VI) If no bids are placed between 14:55 hours to 15.00 hours, the bidding will conclude at 15.00 hours.

c). Validity:

The Buyers must keep their bids valid for a period of 60 days from the date of Closing of on-line auction. No Buyer is permitted to withdraw their quoted rate within the validity period. In case of Withdrawal of offer, the EMD will be forfeited and TNPL may claim additional expenses if any incurred from the Buyer due to withdrawal of offer by him.

Other terms & Conditions

- 01 The Auction will be organized only through Internet. Sale is on "AS IS WHERE IS BASIS" and "NO COMPLAINT BASIS". No complaint regarding quality, quantity or composition of the material will be entertained.
- 02 Rights of participation will be for people who after inspecting the material, pre qualify themselves by paying the EMD and who have not been previously blacklisted by TNPL. Final decision regarding participation will be with TNPL.
- 03 The quantity in LOT indicated of Scrap Item is only and the Buyer has to clear all available in lot must be only for Basic price. Excise Duty and Taxes extra as applicable shall be payable at prevailing rate at the time of dispatch.
- 04 The Company reserves the right to withdraw wholly or partially any or all the items set for sale at any time during the period of contract without assigning any reason.
- 05 Sale confirmation, Sale Order, Invoices etc. will be released only in the name of the Buyer who has initially registered and participated in the Auction. There will not be any change between the registration and completion of transaction.
- 06 All payments to be made in favour of M/s.Tamil Nadu Newsprint and Papers Ltd., payable at Karur.
- 07 Only Buyer's representative authorized by the Company will be allowed for the loading / handling of the waste. However if the need arises for additional person, the same may be allowed only at the discretion of the TNPL.
- 08 In the event of the failure of the Buyer by way of a default in payment of the material being disposed, partial lifting of waste or non-compliance of any of the terms mentioned herein, the contract will automatically stand terminated and the Security Deposit will stand forfeited for the breach of contract by the Buyer.

In this case, the company reserves the right to dispose off the balance material in the Lot and the said Buyer will have no claim whatsoever.
- 09 The rates offered by the highest Bidder will remain firm throughout the contract.

- 10 While taking delivery of the material, if any damage is caused to the premises or other machinery lying nearby, the Company shall recover all such costs required to reinstate the damage into the original position and stop delivery of the material till all the costs are paid.
- 11 Material lifting shall be as per the guidelines of TNPL only. Buyer shall have no rights to choose / pick the material out of due total lot.
- 12 For the personnel employed at site of the execution of the work as per contract, insurance to be arranged by the Buyer. Buyer shall comply with various provisions of the labour laws and be liable for the loss of any of the equipment, tools & tackles or injury to their personnel for which an insurance to be taken by the Buyer.
- 13 The Buyer shall be responsible to ensure that their employees follow safety regulations and as per TNPL stipulations and other statutory regulations. Buyer shall ensure that all his workmen on site use safety belts, gloves, helmets, masks, Safety Shoes, Goggles etc., as necessary for their safety.
- 14 Lots sold on Accumulated/Arranged basis at the auction must be removed by the Purchaser before stipulated time. Once the goods / materials are taken out of the factory gate, Buyer will be solely responsible for all sort of claims like shortage, missing parts, damage, incident, accident, loss of material etc.
- 15 It will be successful Buyer's responsibility to weigh the empty truck at the weighbridge and produce the necessary weighment certificate so that the weight of the empty truck will be deducted from the weight of the fully loaded truck. TNPL weighbridge weighment will be final and binding.
- 16 Should the original Buyer wish to take delivery of the waste material through a representative, he must authorize the latter by a letter of authority, which shall be presented to the officer concerned. The officer concerned may in his entire discretion decline to act on any such authority and it shall be for the Buyer to satisfy the officer concerned that the authority is genuine. Delivery to such person shall be sole responsibility of the Buyer and no claim shall lie against the Company on any account whatsoever, if delivery is offered to a wrong person.
- 17 In case of any dispute regarding the contract, the decision of the Company shall be final and binding. If there is any dispute as to the last or highest bid, the dispute shall be determined by the company and their decision shall be final and binding to all.
- 18 Buyer and his men are subject to the security rule of TNPL in force while in the TNPL premises. Buyer's workmen, agents or representatives shall not commit any nuisance, theft or indulge in any anti-social activities in the premises and the Buyer shall be liable for the good conduct, safety and discipline of his workmen. In case of any such activity, delivery will be suspended and strict action as per law will be taken including forfeiture of EMD.
- 19 Each lot will be sold as a complete lot, which is the selling quantity for delivery. The quantity indicated against each lot is approximate and no guarantee can be given regarding actual tonnage in the lot. Successful Bidder will have to lift the entire quantity as per the tonnage given against each lot.
