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Qualifying factors of the tender:

Please note that the following are the qualifying factors of the Tender. Tenderers who do not comply with the conditions with documentary proof (wherever required) will not be qualified in the Tender for Price Bid stage.

1. TENDERER SHOULD BE A MANUFACTURER. IN CASE OF DEALER, AUTHORISATION LETTER IN ORIGINAL FROM THE MANUFACTURER IS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH TECHNICAL BID WITHOUT FAIL.

Our SIX MONTHS requirement of **HYDROGEN PEROXIDE WITH 50% CONC. is 1200 MT**. The quantity indicated is only approximate and it may vary on either side and TNPL does not guarantee for the same.

02.SPECIFICATION:-

REJECTION CRITERIA: Supplies with purity below 50% will be rejected.

03.QUALITY:

Quality is the essence of this tender. The supplier shall supply the material strictly as per the specification mentioned above. The material supplied will be inspected at our factory. Quantity as ascertained on receipt of material at our Site will be treated as quantity supplied wherever the package/materials are received intact. For each supply/consignment, test/quality certificate should be sent without fail. **As regards quality, our laboratory analysis report will be final and our decision on acceptance or rejection will be final and binding on you.**

04. VALIDITY:

The rate quoted during on line auction should be kept valid for a minimum period of **45** days from the date of Reverse Auction held / opening of Price Bid. During the validity period, bidder is not permitted to make any upward revision in the rate. The order shall be kept valid for a period of **SIX MONTHS** with a provision for further extension of one month from the date of expiry of validity period of the order. During the validity period of the order or its extended period, no upward revision in price will be allowed except in case of increase in statutory levies.

05. TRANSPORTATION:

- b) The material should be despatched in tankers by road on freight PAID basis. Freight charges shall be claimed by way of separate Debit Note. If separate work order to be issued for transportation, the same should be indicated in the Serial no.4 (b) of the Technical cum Commercial Bid along with name and address of the transporter and a consent letter from them.
- c) It is the sole responsibility of the supplier to settle the applicable Service Tax to the statutory Authorities in case of their claiming freight charges through Invoice / Debit note.
- d) Please clearly state the terms of offer i.e whether delivery is F.O.R Kagithapuram or F.O.R despatching station or Ex factory. If packing and forwarding charges are extra, please state the charges applicable clearly.

06. TERMS OF PAYMENT:

- Our normal terms of payment is within 30 days from the date of receipt of material subject to acceptance by **State Bank of India – Karur Cheque**. However, it may please be noted that offers asking payment in advance or through bank are liable for rejection.
- Alternatively, we are now having the facility of sending payment to the customers through RTGS Scheme through our Bankers M/s.Indian Overseas Bank, Kandampalayam Branch, Velayuthampalayam, Karur District and M/s.State Bank of India, Pugalur Branch, Kagithapuram.

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07. DUTIES AND TAXES:

Duties, Educational Cess on ED, Secondary Higher Education Cess and taxes etc if applicable should be mentioned clearly and separately with the percentage of duties and taxes applicable.

CENVAT:

Duplicate copy of Excise duty invoice should be sent along with each supply for the purpose of availing CENVAT credit. Copy of ED invoice should be sent in a separate cover addressed to A.G.M (Stores) as may be specified in the purchase order. Without copy of ED invoice, material will not be unloaded. Educational Cess @ 2% & Secondary Higher Education Cess @ 1% on ED shall also be Cenvatable.

Please note that, as TNPL shall avail CENVAT benefit, please mention clearly in the offer the applicable Excise duty and Educational Cess Secondary Higher Education Cess. TNPL shall take the same into consideration while evaluating the offers.

VALUE ADDED TAX (VAT): Please note that with effect from 01.01.2007, Tamilnadu Government has implemented VAT system. Under the proposed VAT system, TNPL is eligible to avail set off for the sales Tax paid on the purchases made within the state. While evaluating the offers, the above shall be taken into consideration. You should submit Bills as detailed below:-

- (a) All the suppliers have to raise the Tax invoices as prescribed by the VAT Act 2006.
- (b) The supplier's Tax Payers Identification No(TIN) and CST No. shall be printed in all the tax invoices without fail (TIN Registration Certificate Xerox Copy is to be enclosed along with the Technical-cum-Commercial Bid without fail).

08. HYDROGEN PEROXIDE WITH 50% CONC. shall be **supplied in tankers by road.**

09. DELIVERY:

In the event of an order, you shall be in a position to start supplies within short notice and despatches are to be effected as per delivery schedule given by TNPL from time to time.

10. DELAY OR NON DELIVERY:

Time is the essence of the contract and completion of delivery dates agreed to are binding on the seller. In the event the seller is not able to supply as per the delivery schedules given by TNPL, Purchaser will have a right either to cancel the order without prejudice to any other rights or to make purchase from an alternate source at the risk and cost of the seller.

11. REJECTION:

TNPL requires HYDROGEN PEROXIDE WITH 50% CONC. strictly as per our specification given in S.No.2 above. Material not meeting our specification will be rejected outright and the rejected material shall be taken back within 7 days and replacement should be made within 7 days from the date of intimation.

12. In case of rejection and failure to replace goods, the order will be treated as incomplete and we may cancel the order and will arrange to purchase the goods from elsewhere at your risk and cost and the purchase order on you will be cancelled and action taken as per the order terms .

13. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

All the bidders are required to pay an EMD of Rs.50,000/- by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of **M/s TAMIL NADU NEWSPRINT AND PAPERS LIMITED payable at KARUR.** This amount will not bear any interest and will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders after finalisation of the orders. Offers received without EMD is liable for rejection.

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14. The tender should be valid for a minimum period of 45 DAYS from the date of Reverse auction held / opening of price bid. No bidder is permitted to withdraw his offer within the validity period of the tender or before finalisation of the order. In case any bidder withdraws his offer within the validity period of the offer or before finalisation of the order, the EMD amount paid by him will be forfeited.

15. The EMD of the successful bidder will be converted into Security Deposit. This amount will not bear any interest and will be refunded on satisfactory completion of the order. This amount shall stand forfeited in the event of cancellation of order due to unsatisfactory performance of the seller.

17. TRANSIT RISK & INSURANCE:

Transit insurance should be arranged by the supplier at their cost .

18. WEIGHT VARIATION CLAUSE:

Weight variation upto 0.5% on total weight is permissible to take care of Weigh Bridge to Weigh Bridge variation. However, if the weight variation exceeds 0.5%, the actual weight recorded in TNPL Weigh Bridge will be taken for accounting and payment purpose.

19. The suppliers are permitted to deal only with the Purchase Dept.

20. CANCELLATION:

In the event of unsatisfactory performance in executing the order as per the terms, the order is liable for cancellation. In the event of cancellation, the Security Deposit will be forfeited. TNPL reserves the right to exercise the Risk Purchase Option given in Clause (21) of the General Terms and conditions of the tender. Also the TNPL reserves its right to cancel the order in full or part thereof without giving any reason by giving 15days notice if the material is not required due to any reason.

21. RISK PURCHASE:
