01.QUANTITY:

Supply of **BAGASSE COMPACTOR – 1 NO. (Details as per Annexure – II)**

02.VALIDITY:

The rate quoted should be valid for a period of minimum 90 days from the date of opening of price bids. During the validity period, bidder is not permitted to make any upward revision in the rates. The order should be valid till execution of the order. During the validity period of the order or its extended period, no upward increase in price will be allowed, except in case of any increase in statutory levies.

No bidder is permitted to withdraw his offer or increase the rate within the validity period of the tender or before finalisation of the order. In case any bidder withdraws his offer or increases the rate within the validity period of the offer or before finalisation of the tender, the EMD amount paid by him will be forfeited.

03.DELIVERY:

The successful bidder should complete the supply within 2 months from the date of receipt of approved drawing and thereafter erection shall be completed within 15 days from the date of site clearance.

The technical specification and scope for Supply, Erection & Commissioning of Bagasse compactor 30 MT per hour capacity, complete with cylinder assemblies, hydraulic power pack, electrical controls, development of drawings & fabrication of main frame, ram feed hoper etc., are as below:

Scope of Supply, Erection and Services

The scope of supply includes supply of Bagasse compactor with cylinder assembly, hydraulic power pack, electrical control panel, fabricated main frame, ram feed hoper etc.,as that of existing equipment available with TNPL. The equipment should be assembled, tested and no load trials to be carried out before despatch.

Supplied compactor should be erected and commissioned at the TNPL Offsite.

Supplier shall attend the Technical discussion arranged by TNPL at Kagithapuram office / any one of the offsites with TNPL Engineers from the respective sites to find out any modification / improvement to be done in the new compactor to be supplied to overcome the problems being faced in the existing compactor in a convenient date before submission of drawing for approval. Any suggestions given by them shall be incorporated in the newly supplied compactor.

EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATION:

Ram Unit:

The Ram Unit is supported on four wheels which move on rails. It is powered by hydraulic cylinder. It also carries a saddle which operates limit switches. These limit switches control the slab size and density of bagasse after compaction.

Compression Chamber:

The bagasse fed through a hopper by gravity flow, is collected at the central part of the compactor, called the compaction chamber. The bagasse flow is continuous, and therefore even during the forward stroke of the ram, the material is allowed to collect on the top place of the ram. When the ram retracts, the bagasse on the top plate of the ram is swept into the compaction chamber, while fresh bagasse continues to fill through the hopper, before the forward movement of the ram recommences.

The forward movement of the ram compresses the bagasse in the compression chamber against the weight of material which has already been compacted, lined up in the after pressure & release chamber and on the goose neck conveyor. Towards the end of the forward stroke, the whole mass, both of the already compacted and the freshly compressed bagasse is being pushed forward causing the last portion of the compacted bagasse to overhang the end of the conveyor. At the point of overhang in the tip of goose neck, it breaks off in blocks under its own weight. The ram is ready to retract, for repeating the cycle.

The Latches (Bagasse Retainers):

Springs operated latches on either sides of the compression chamber hold the compacted material and prevent it from drawing back into the chamber when the ram is retracted.

Bale Chamber (After Pressure & Release Chamber):

From the compression chamber the compacted material flows through the 'Bale' chamber.

The bale chamber is of collapsible in construction. One end of the top and side section are connected to the compression chamber with strong hinge pins, while at the other end is a toggle mechanism. The toggle mechanism consists of a pair of collapsible arms. The collapsible arms are adjusted to tighten / release the compacted Bagasse in the bale chamber by suitable screw rod arrangement.

The toggle mechanism is adjustable to control bale release or increase the density of the bale, or prevent overloading of the main hydraulic system by suitable screw arrangement.

The top, bottom surface and side flaps of the bale chamber will be lined with stainless steel plates to achieve smooth discharge of bales.



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ANNEXURE II

Electrical Systems:

A fully automatic and sequentially timed electrical circuit controls the hydraulic system. The timers can be varied to suit different rates of incoming materials flow, moisture content and the compaction density required.

A control panel consists of main incoming isolator of 125A switch, a star delta starter for motors with electrically interlocked, all necessary contractor, timer, fuses and push buttons of Siemens make. The control circuit operates with 110 volts.

Additional operating control desk with forward / reverse stroke & emergency bush buttons, auto / manual toggle switch and Motor 1 / Motor 2 toggle switch.

Under normal circumstances the ram is slowed down by the pressure of material approximately 300 mm from the end of the stroke. It is achieved by an unloading valve set at a given pressure allowing the large volume pump to dump to the tank.

If the ram operates without any material a limit switch set a 150 mm from the end of the stroke will operate the unloading valve electrically and slow the ram down.

Hydraulic System:

The hydraulic system consists of a high-low circuit, which aids fast approach and slow compression by the ram. A built in hydraulic regeneration helps in the fast acceleration of the ram cylinder during forward movement.

The hydraulic system is supported by standby power units which ensure failsafe operation.

INSPECTION AND TESTING:

Stage inspection shall be carried out at supplier's works at TNPL's discretion and supplier shall inform TNPL the status of the work accordingly to enable TNPL to depute their Engineer. In case TNPL Engineer desires to waive the inspection; it shall be informed to the supplier accordingly. Inspection by TNPL Engineer at supplier's works does not absolve supplier's responsibility of guarantee on workmanship.

Test certificate should be provided for all tests performed, whether or not witnessed by TNPL or its representative. Six (6) copies of the certificate should be supplied to TNPL on satisfactory completion of the tests.

TNPL or its authorised representative reserves the right to inspect or expedite any item of equipment at the works of the manufacturer or his sub-contractor at any state during the course of manufacture, assembly or testing. Any such inspection shall not absolve supplier of his obligations under the contract or reduce of his obligations.

INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED ALONG WITH OFFER:

Supplier shall provide all the information called for within the different section of these specifications.

The description of equipment offered shall specify important features to enable TNPL to obtain a comprehensive understanding of equipment being offered.

All drawings and documents shall be in English language and all dimensions and weights shall be in metric units

Specification and material of construction shall be listed for all major items of equipment.
