**TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1 Quantity : Annual estimated generation is 90,000 MT. TNPL does not guarantee for the Quantity.

2. The following material is available for disposal on "As is where is" basis:-

4. **TNPL reserves the right to cancel this tender at any time without assigning any reason at its discretion . TNPL reserves the right to reject any/all tenders without assigning any reason at its discretion. The sale order may be issued to one/more than one tenderer at the discretion of TNPL.**

5. The Earnest Money deposit of the successful bidder shall be converted into Security Deposit and shall be returned after satisfactory completion of the sale order.

6. Before winding up the operation at Mill site at the end of the contract period, the buyer shall obtain a work completion certificate from the Section-in-charge. In case of non – compliance to the conditions of the sale order, TNPL reserves the right to cancel the sale order and award the same on alternate source at the cost of the buyer and the Security Deposit will be forfeited.

7. The buyer shall be allowed to lift the material only after making advance payment for the quantity available including the applicable taxes. The remittance has to be made by Demand Draft in favour of Tamil Nadu Newsprint And Papers Limited payable at Karur. The buyer shall keep a recurring Advance amount equivalent to one month expected quantity of material rounded off to the nearest thousand.

8. The buyer should produce the TIN & PAN Number and a copy of the documentary proof along with Tender.

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**9. ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS FOR DISPOSAL OF EFFLUENT SLUDGE GR.III  
(LIME SLUDGE) FROM LIME MUD FILTERS :**

- 1) **A copy of Valid Consent Order to operate standing in the name of the tenderer issued by TNPCB under both Water and Air act to store TNPL Lime sludge should be submitted along with tender document.**
- 2) Period of sale order will be limited up to the validity of the consent order
- 3) If the storage land is owned by the tenderer, sufficient valid documentary proof should be submitted along with tender document.
- 4) If the storage land is a lease land, lease deed in Rs.100/= stamp paper, signed by 2 witnesses should be submitted along with tender document.

**PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED BY WASTE MATERIALS HANDLING BUYERS**

- ? Buyer shall ensure that the body, platform and doors of the trucks are in good condition. The trucks will be inspected periodically by the officer in charge for the above and defects, if any, noticed, shall be rectified immediately by the concerned contractors. During the time of repair, alternative trucks have to be mobilized by the Buyer.
- ✍ Buyer shall collect / load the material to three inches lower than the side body / door height.
- ✍ Materials shall be evenly levelled within the body of the vehicle immediately after collection / loading.
- ✍ Before moving the trucks out of the loading / collection point, material sticking to tyres must be cleaned by scraping / water washing.
- ✍ All trucks carrying waste materials shall move through the specified route to the dump yard.
- ✍ Contractors shall ensure that waste materials does not spill from the trucks during transportation from the collection point to dump yards.

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## **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR FORWARD AUCTION**

### **I). SELECTION PROCESS OF BUYERS:**

- a) Buyers must submit the process compliance statement duly signed, to TNPL before 48 hours of the commencement of auction.
- b) Subsequently, TNPL would communicate the opening price, bid increment and alias name through Internet.
- c) On the event date, Buyers shall submit bids from their computers through Internet on [www.tnpltenders.com](http://www.tnpltenders.com). As and when other Buyers place the bids, they would have the opportunity to revise their bids upwards, if they wish to do so.
- d) Buyers must communicate their final bid amount by fax or E-mail to TNPL immediately after the bid event. This may be followed by a hard copy communication of price by post or courier.

### **Other terms & Conditions**

- 1 Sale is on "AS IS WHERE IS BASIS" and "NO COMPLAINT BASIS". No complaint regarding quality, quantity or composition of the material will be entertained.
- 2 Rights of participation will be for people who after inspecting the material, pre qualify themselves by paying the EMD and who have not been previously blacklisted by TNPL. Final decision regarding participation will be with TNPL.
- 3 Sale confirmation, Sale Order, Invoices etc. will be released only in the name of the Buyer who has initially registered and participated in the Auction. There will not be any change between the registration and completion of transaction.
- 4 All payments to be made in favour of M/s.Tamil Nadu Newsprint and Papers Ltd., payable at Karur.
- 5 Should the original Buyer wish to take delivery of the waste material through a representative, he must authorize the latter by a letter of authority, which shall be presented to the officer concerned. The officer concerned may in his entire discretion decline to act on any such authority and it shall be for the Buyer to satisfy the officer concerned that the authority is genuine. Delivery to such person shall be sole responsibility of the Buyer and no claim shall lie against the Company on any account whatsoever, if delivery is offered to a wrong person.
- 6 In the event of the failure of the Buyer by way of a default in payment of the material being disposed, partial lifting of waste or non-compliance of any of the terms mentioned herein, the contract will automatically stand terminated and the Security Deposit will stand forfeited for the breach of contract by the Buyer. In this case, the company reserves the right to dispose off the balance material in the Lot and the said Buyer will have no claim whatsoever.
- 7 The rates offered by the highest Bidder will remain firm throughout the contract period.
- 8 While taking delivery of the material, if any damage is caused to the premises or other machinery lying nearby, the Company shall recover all such costs required to reinstate the damage into the original position and stop delivery of the material till all the costs are paid.
- 9 Material lifting shall be as per the guidelines of TNPL only. Buyer should keep sufficient trucks to collect the lime sludge below the chute on continuous basis and also to collect material that is kept on ground
- 10 For the personnel employed at site of the execution of the work as per contract, insurance to be arranged by the Buyer. Buyer shall comply with various provisions of the labour laws and be liable for the loss of any of the equipment, tools & tackles or injury to their personnel for which an insurance to be taken by the Buyer.
- 11 The Buyer shall be responsible to ensure that their employees follow safety regulations and as per TNPL stipulations and other statutory regulations. Buyer shall ensure that all

his workmen on site use safety belts, gloves, helmets, masks, Safety Shoes, Goggles etc., as necessary for their safety.

- 12 It will be successful Buyer's responsibility to weigh the empty truck at the weighbridge and produce the necessary weighment certificate so that the weight of the empty truck will be deducted from the weight of the fully loaded truck. TNPL weighbridge weighment will be final and binding. Any rule or procedure ruling at the time of supply will be applicable.
- 13 In case of any dispute regarding the contract, the decision of the Company shall be final and binding. If there is any dispute as to the last or highest bid, the dispute shall be determined by the company and their decision shall be final and binding to all.
- 14 Buyer and his men are subject to the security rule of TNPL in force while in the TNPL premises. Buyer's workmen, agents or representatives shall not commit any nuisance, theft or indulge in any anti-social activities in the premises and the Buyer shall be liable for the good conduct, safety and discipline of his workmen. In case of any such activity, delivery will be suspended and strict action as per law will be taken including forfeiture of EMD.
